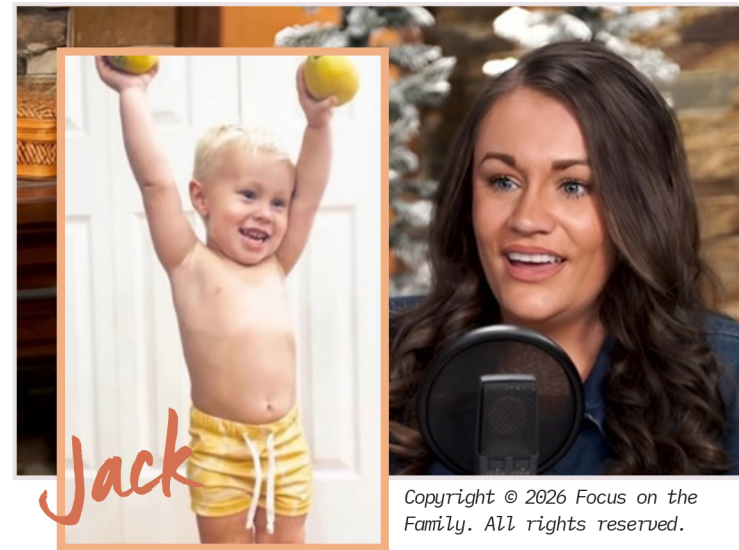
Expanding our reach

As we begin 2026, one of the most encouraging developments at You Medical is the continued need for increased appointment availability. Because of your support, we have maintained expanded clinic hours and staffing so more women and families can be seen when decisions are urgent and time sensitive. Our goal is simple: when someone reaches out, there is an appointment available. We continue to seek additional volunteers to help meet this need, but our usable space (particularly limited bathroom capacity) has become our greatest challenge, creating congestion in hallways and patient areas.

To responsibly support this growth, we are exploring facility improvements. Our draft expansion plan includes adding a much-needed

staff and volunteer restroom; currently, two bathrooms are shared by patients, staff, and volunteers. Because most medical appointments require bathroom use, this space is heavily relied upon throughout the day. We are grateful for our building and the opportunity it provides, including a full basement. We are now evaluating options to finish the basement to include a dedicated staff and volunteer restroom, a larger training space, a small lunchroom that would free an additional medical room upstairs, and improved boutique donation processing space. These changes would reduce congestion and improve the overall patient experience. We look forward to sharing these early plans during our Open House on April 30, where you can see how your partnership is helping prepare You Medical to meet growing needs.

In closing, I also hope you are enjoying the refreshed look of the newsletter and the expanded updates designed to keep you informed about the work you make possible. Each day we witness tangible reminders of God's provision. Even as I write, I can hear a baby in the lobby, a small but powerful reminder of God's sovereignty and grace. Thank you for partnering with us so that His love can be reflected and poured out to those who may not yet recognize the value and sanctity of life.

On the way to the clinic, however, Kourtney had a powerful encounter with God that changed her life forever—and eventually, changed the course of her dad and her entire family's life, as well. Rapid rise of mail-order and telemedicine abortion pills

The Ohio Senate Health Committee heard testimony on Senate Bill 309, the Abortion Pill Provider Liability Education (APPLE) Act, the Ohio's version of National Right to Life's model law, the Abortion Pill Provider Liability and Education Act. The intent of both is absolutely clear. By focusing on informed consent, transparency, and accountability in the growing chemical abortion marketplace, ensure that women receive truthful information and clear notice of their legal rights before being prescribed abortion-inducing drugs. Ingrid Duran is director of the Department of State Legislation for National Right to Life (NRLC). In written testimony submitted to the committee, she explained that the APPLE Act responds to the “rapid rise of mail-order and telemedicine abortion pills” that increasingly bypass traditional medical safeguards.
